Marietta's "Notify Me" Alerts – How it Works

Subscription Signup Process:

1. Resident enters email address in the "Notify me" section of the homepage.

2. Resident enters phone number if they elect to receive text messages, chooses a delivery preference and enters an optional password.

3. Resident is able to subscribe to all available subscription topics through one succinct subscription page.

Automation of Email Delivery:

When the City of Marietta's "Current News Releases" page is updated, via this RSS feed, an email is automatically created and delivered to interested residents (with the content of the new press release populating the email).
