The City of Ann Arbor has been recognized by [e.Republic's Center for Digital Government and Digital Communities](#) magazine for its online services.

The Digital Cities Survey ranked Ann Arbor No. 7 on its list of "best digital cities" in its population category of 75,000 to 124,999.

Services at the city's Web site - www.a2gov.org - include:

- The new "TRAKiT" feature provides access to development review and building inspections.
- "GovDelivery," a subscription service for e-mail notifications, has road or lane closures, general news and other subjects.
- "Citizen request system," an online tool, allows for submitting service requests for parks maintenance, pothole and street light repair, and other services.
