**The City of St. Paul has updated its email alert system to include wireless communication. The city already has 11,000 subscribers to a web-based service that notifies people when the city's web site has been updated with information in which the subscriber is interested. Now, subscribers with cell phones, pagers and other wireless devices can get those messages without being in front of a computer. Scott Burns is the CEO of GovDocs, the St. Paul-based company that provides the service for the city.**

**"Anything that has kind of a time-sensitive component. We have a number of customers around the country using it for crime alerts," comments GovDocs CEO, Scott Burns, "So if there's a crime alert in your particular neighborhood you can find out about it by cell phone." Burns also mentioned other information subscribers find useful, such as snow emergencies, "Obviously, traffic and transit information is very useful."**
